Common Registration Errors

GUIDE FOR Clubs and Managers – List of common errors in the registration process

1. Photographs – We need a current recently taken (within last 3 months) passport style photograph of head and shoulders only

Acceptable photos are those that the Passport Office would accept – other will be rejected and delay the player's registration.

NOT a photos of passport photo which is watermarked;

NOT a photo holding trophies;

NOT a full body or three quarter body shots;

NOT a photos of a photo;

NOT a photos edited from a squad photo;

NOT a blurred photo.

NOT a photo with watermarks or any other details on the photo;

NOT a photo of someone else – like a Primer League Player (This will result in player being denied football in the Alliance for the full season).

2. Proof of Age - Dates of birth entered in the player's profile page DO NOT match the copy of the birth certificate/ passport supplied. Errors are entering the date of birth with the current year.
3. Proof of Age - Birth cert/passport/driving license are too small to read or blurred.
4. Proof of Age - Birth cert/passport/driving license do not relate to the player record i.e. names are not the same.
5. U7s to U21s Player record has no address details.
6. U7s to U18s Player records has no Parent/Guardian details.
7. U7s to U18s Guardian Online email has not been issued by team managers thus Player records has no parent/guardian details.
8. Foreign proof of age documentation – these may mean the player will be subject to gaining international clearance from the Football Association, which can take 6 weeks.
