Note 1	Delayed Fixtures - Teams SHALL be available to play re-scheduled matches on ANY fixture date or delayed fixture date as shown above.
Note 2	A Team being unable to supply a home venue for whatever reason (frost, snow, waterlogged etc) SHALL offer their opponents the opportunity to play the game at their opponent's ground on that day if the kick off time can be arranged within 1 hours of the original set by the Team whose pitch is unavailable. Any fixture not taking place in these circumstances shall be reviewed by the Management Committee who shall have the power to inflict a fine and/or award the points or otherwise deal with the matter at their discretion. Circumstances such as travelling distances and kick off times shall all be taken into account when the Management Committee makes their decision.
Note 3	In the event of a match not being played or abandoned owing to causes over which neither Team has control, it shall be played in its entirety on a date to be mutually agreed by the two Teams and approved by the Management Committee. Failing such agreement and notification to the Divisional Secretary within three (3) days of the original match the Management Committee shall have power to order the match to be played on a named date or on or before a given date. U12 to U21 Managers who wish to claim a match must do so withing three (3) days of the match in writing to their Div Sec, explaining the reason under which they are claiming the match .
Note 4	Divisional Secretary can schedule any EBFA match on a League, Cup or delayed fixture date, providing five (5) days notice of the match. The League can only schedule matches on Saturdays. Teams can agree to play on non-Saturday dates - once both Managers have agreed this fixture with the Div Sec then the fixture becomes an official fixture on FA Full Time and all EBFA rules apply.
Note 5	Over Easter weekends- teams can play matches if both teams and Div Secretary agree to fixtures on these 2 weekends
