For your Clubs insurance reasons and FA Standard Code of Rules, a player may not register or play in a wrong age group. The FA makes no exceptions whatsoever.

School Year (*)

The school year is only a guide; always use Date of Birth to determine age group.

Proof of Age (Date of Birth and Nationality)

When registering a player, who did not play in your Club, in the 2022/23 season, then as proof of age/proof of birth place document (POA/POBP) is required. The POA/POBP document must be a scan (pdf or jpg) of the player's birth certificate or passport that clearly shows date of birth and place of birth, uploaded to the www.gotsport.com system.

All Player registrations are done via the www.gotsport.com portal:

Jun-23 to 31-Jul-23 – GotSport Player registrations are free
01-Aug-23 to 31-Mar-24 – Player registrations is £7.50

If player being registered to your team for 2023/24 season which were in your Club/Team in 2022/23 season then.

Club GotSport administrator can move players from team to team – do not create a new record for a player who is already in your club, get your Club GotSport administrator to move players from team to team.

The “V” padlock by the Date of Birth means the player has been Verified for Name, Date of Birth and Nationality (ITC Place of Birth).

Player requires a new passport style and size photo, which has been taken in the last 3 months – editing of photos will be charged for. – See common errors document on www.eastberksfa.com and use the template for photos. Note leaving this to your parents to upload is very expensive for your club.

Check the players address, email, mobile and parent’s details, such as emails, are up to date.

To get the guardians to complete the Guardian Agreement Form you need to send the player an email and tick the Add Login details checkbox – See Procedure on www.eastberksfa.com

Once the player the player has a complicate photo, address, email, and the guardians have completed the online Guardian Agreement form then the system will allow the League to register the player to the team. If anything is missing, then the player cannot be registered and without a Player Registration ID card and “U-” at start of the players Jersey field then player cannot play in EBFA matches for 2023/24.

If player being registered to your team and is new to your Club/Team for 2023/24 then.

Check if the player requires International Clearance – this can take 6 weeks to 9 months – Read the FA website for the latest advice on International Clearance. The Home Office can fine you up to £10,000 if you get this wrong.

Player requires a new passport style and size photo, which has been taken in the last 3 months – editing of photos will be charged for. – See common errors document on www.eastberksfa.com and use the template for photos. Note leaving this to your parents to upload is very expensive for your club.

Each player’s full address is required on the registration with Postcode.

Each player needs a guardian email.

Parent information needs to be completed – with emails

Each player needs to have their Name, Date of Birth and Nationality/Place of Birth Verified by the League. This is done by uploading a scan (pdf or jpg) to the players record that is a copy of their Passport Page, Birth Certificate or Driving License. Previous seasons Player registration cards cannot be used for validation.

Once the League has validated the Name, Date of Birth and Nationality/Place of Birth a yellow “V” padlock will appear by the Date of Birth filed, which means the player has been validated and that these details can only be updated by the League on GotSport.

Check the players address, email, mobile and parent’s details, such as emails, are up to date.

To get the guardians to complete the Guardian Agreement Form you need to send the player an email and tick the Add Login details checkbox – See Procedure on www.eastberksfa.com

Once the player the player has a complicate photo, address, email, and the guardians have completed the online Guardian Agreement form then the system will allow the League to register the player to the team. If anything is missing, then the player cannot be registered and without a Player Registration ID card cannot play in EBFA matches.

Whole Game System – Football Association Player Registration System (FA-PRS)

Clubs are also required by the Football Association to register their players to a team on Whole Game System (WGS) FA Player Registration system (FA-PRS).

Clubs/Teams must submit their WGS player registrations to the League on the WGS so the EBFA League can approve the WGS registration, once the GotSport Player Registration is complete.

Then EBFA will check the player has completed the full registered process on GotSport and will then approve the player on WGS. On Approval EBFA will update the GotSport Player Registration record with an update to the start of the Player Jersey number with "U-", which means the player can play in EBFA 23/24 matches.

If the players has "N-", in the jersey field, then player has not completed GotSport player registrations and cannot play in EBFA 23/24 matches.

If the players has "Q-" at the start of the Jersey field, then player played last season 22/23, but player has not completed GotSport player registrations for 23/24 season and has no WGS record submitted and again cannot play in EBFA 23/24 matches.

If the player has "N-F", in the jersey field, then player has not completed GotSport player registrations and cannot play in EBFA 23/24 matches, as the "F" indicates that the players WGS FAN number has not been entered into the GotSport Player registration record.

The EBFA GotSport to WGS verification process is:

Player Completed GotSport Player Registration process. Note GotSport Player Registration is audited and locked for Legal 1st and Surname matching a Passport or Birth Certificate and a Deed Poll if actioned and provided. The (EBFA League ONLY supports the use of legal names.)
Player does not required FA/FIFA International Clearance or has been Granted ITC or ITC Exception by FA Registration Dept..
Player has a high quality compliant head & shoulder photo of the player, taken in last 3 months.
Player has Full Address on GotSport
Player has League Player/Guardian Agreement Form completed for 23/24.

Player ID Card may or may not printed from GotSport.

Jersey Field will starts with "Q-" or "N"-.

WGS records, which have been submitted To League by Clubs are downloaded from WGS and processed against GotSport completed Players.

GotSport/WGS Player Registrations System checks that :

Legal First Name in WGS matches the audited GotSport registration.
Legal Surname in WGS matches the audited GotSport registration.
Middle Initials/Names should not be entered on WGS.
Date of Birth in WGS Matches DOB that has been audited in GotSport
Player is registered in WGS to the team that they are registered as a Player of in GotSport.

If Player's WGS does not compile to above, on WGS the player approval request will be Rejected on WGS and player not authorised to play football in EBFA.

Once a player is registered on GotSport a Player ID Card will be printed and then the process to verify
